The Third Judicial Circuit Court Interpreter Program is dedicated to providing qualified interpreters to non-English speaking litigants in the courtroom. Interpreters are hired by Court Administration on an event-by-event basis and can be provided for most court events. Currently, the Circuit is working with the interpreters to ensure that all of the interpreters have the opportunity to obtain the training needed to become certified by July 1, 2008.
